Sub Brit Forum Posting Guidelines – A Reminder from the Moderators



Purpose & Scope

The Sub Brit Forum is a place for civilised discussion and exchange of information between members. It is driven by members' input and lightly moderated by members to try to ensure it is achieving these aims.

Posts can be on virtually any subject relevant to man-made or man-used underground spaces and related matters and subjects of interest such as military or civil defence matters, references sources and even torches!

What not to post

- Posts, including any linked content, should not involve or condone illegal activity or access.
- Information on operational sites should not be shared unless it is already legitimately in the public domain.
- Material already reported in mainstream media should not normally be reiterated on the Forum unless you are able to add some additional information or insight. In particular, don't constantly re-post single source material: if other members are interested in the channel, they can subscribe to it themselves.
- Help keep the Forum timely and relevant by not posting material if it's already more than a few months old.
- Avoid expressing political or religious views: please use other forums if you want to discuss such matters.
- Don't criticise individuals, although you are free to challenge their ideas!

Say clearly what (& why) you are posting

- The title of the Post should clearly reflect its content.
- If you wish to link content to your Post, fully review it beforehand to ensure it is relevant, useful and suitable for sharing. Your Post should contain a description of the content and, in the case of videos, how long they are and, if appropriate, where the relevant section starts.

Responding to Posts

- Comments on Posts should add constructively to the discussion.
- If you simply like a Post, hit the "Like" button rather than adding pointlessly to the thread by saying so.
- If you perceive a problem with a Post, flag the Post, and state what the problem is. Please don't compound the issue by replying with a comment complaining about it. The Moderators will act on the flag and review the Post. They do not otherwise review Posts.
- If you wish to deviate from the original subject, please start a new thread.

Finally...Think before you Post

What you post to the Forum can potentially be seen by around 1000 members including institutions such as universities, so before you make a Post, please just pause to consider if it abides by the guidelines and, importantly, will add value to the Forum.

Terms of Service

Sub Brit has <u>Terms of Service</u> for the Forum and our overall Website describing your (and our) behaviour and rights related to content, privacy, and laws. This legalese is for everyone's protection and, in using the Forum, you agree to abide by these Terms.

Failure to abide by the Terms of Service, repeated flouting of Forum guidelines or otherwise acting in a way that jeopardises Sub Brit's reputation will result in withdrawal of posting privileges or, exceptionally, in suspension or termination of membership.
